This is to correct an error on the Levy – the amount pursuant to P.A. 93-689 was erroneously deducted from the Pension Fund Levy amount.

Burn Tower – Suggest ordering now, not sure what Tariffs are going to do. It is budgeted for this year. Questions on what happens if the Village does not pass it – it would have to be returned. The chief does not see it not getting passed.

Draft Budget – Trustees were given a copy of the draft budget; this will be approved at the next meeting.

- Budget deficit of \$182,000 includes a lot of contingencies.
- One increase not anticipated was for IT we are going to a managed contract –\$20,000 for the year we are keeping the same person; he started his own company.
- Increase in EMS about \$20,000 for maintenance on power cots and Lucas devise. this is an upfront fee for four years – after this it will be reevaluated
- Revenues up about \$200,000 in ambulance fees
- Questions on grants tons of grants out there we can apply for
